<u>Pest Control</u> – Due to the last Wednesday of the month falling on Christmas Day, <u>pest</u> control and inspections have been moved to Wednesday, <u>December</u> 18th. Consider this your Notice of Entry.

Smoke Alarms/Carbon Monoxide Detectors – New smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors must be installed before the end of the year. This is a new requirement. Maintenance will be in your units throughout December with electricians to finish installation that started Nov. 4th. Please be sure to remove an abundance of clutter to allow access for where maintenance needs to be to install these new alarms. Consider this your Notice of Entry.

<u>Leaving During the Holidays</u> – If you will be away from your unit overnight, please inform the office, especially if there is a chance for freezing weather. <u>Do not</u> turn off the heat in your unit when you leave. <u>Do</u> leave cabinet doors open to allow heat in those areas.

<u>Scholarships</u> - Scholarship awards are available to public housing residents, participants in rental assistance or similar programs, both heads of household and other family members. Visit the following housing websites: www.swnahro.org and www.phada.org for more information. Deadlines are fast approaching.

<u>Christmas Trees</u> - Please <u>do not</u> use any <u>LIVE</u> trees as these could become fire hazards. Remember not to nail, hook, or permanently attach inside or outside lights to the unit (you may use non-damaging clips). All holiday decorations must be removed by **Monday**, **January 13, 2025**.

60-Day/Interim Re-Exams - Attention: Residents on the sixty (60) day interim recertification schedule, please be reminded to keep your appointment completed and bring your paperwork. Re-Exams are December 17th and December 18th. It is YOUR responsibility to provide requested documentation. If you are experiencing difficulties gathering your paperwork and/or keeping your appointment, you must contact the office before your appointment time. Households that do not comply with their lease agreement may be set at flat rate.

<u>Public Hearing</u> – A public hearing will be held on <u>Thursday</u>, <u>January 16</u>, <u>2025 at 10:00am</u> in the Foy Howard Community Center located at 605 Lucas Street (at the main office) to specifically discuss:

- 2025 Annual Plan/Agency Plan
- 5-Year Agency Plan
- Modernizations/Improvements

This is every tenant's opportunity to express cares/concerns about your unit, the area you live, and common areas such as playgrounds and community centers.

<u>WARNING!</u> – There have been attempted thefts around Lucas Circle. It is advised to remove keys from vehicles and keep doors locked. Be mindful of your surroundings. If you see something suspicious, report it to the police.

<u>Food Distribution</u> – There were several bags of food leftover from the November food distribution. Come by the office in December during normal business hours to pick up a bag of food. First come, first serve.

<u>Fire Hazards</u> – Do NOT use space heaters, the oven, or the stovetop to heat the unit. Space heaters are not allowed. The oven and stovetop are not meant to be a source of heat. Additionally, candles are not allowed in units. You may use a wax warmer, but no open flames are allowed in the units.

<u>Under Sink Storage</u> – Be mindful when storing items under the kitchen and bathroom sinks so the area is not over filled. When that area does become over filled, the plumbing can get knocked loose and cause damage because it is not always easily noticeable at first. Tenants will be responsible for damage that occurs due to over storage under the sink.

Non-Emergency After Hours Calls – There has been a significant increase in non-emergency maintenance calls made after hours and on weekends. For any true emergency maintenance work order, call the numbers on the card you were given at the time of your lease signing. If you do not get an answer, then call the CPD and they will contact the Director. Do not contact other office personnel for work orders or emergency maintenance after business hours. Wellness checks should be called into the police department, not Housing Authority maintenance personnel.

What Is An Emergency Work Order? – Work orders that fall under the emergency category are smoke alarms beeping, carbon monoxide detectors going off, plumbing/water issues, electrical, or HVAC/heating issues. This is not an extensive list. Use your best judgment. If you don't know, it is best to call and ask. Maintenance can determine if it is an emergency or if it can wait until regular business hours.

<u>Trash Can</u> - Please remember to "bag" your trash before you place it in your trash can.

<u>Disconnect all garden hoses</u> from outside water faucets before the first heavy frost/freeze. Any tenant whose frozen garden hose causes damage will be responsible for the cost of repair.

No Smoking – There is a no smoking policy. You and all guests must be 25 feet or more away from units when smoking. Smoking in units or on porches is prohibited. This includes tenants and their guests.

Marijuana in Public Housing – Reminder: HUD's official stance on medical marijuana is "NO". This is a FEDERAL RULE. Residents of public housing are not allowed to use cannabis, even for medicinal purposes, on public housing property.

This means it does not matter if your doctor wrote you a prescription, neither you nor your guests are allowed to use medical marijuana on public housing property. <u>Do not let your quest's behavior earn you an eviction.</u>

<u>Sickness</u> – If you have a fever or have been sick during the time of pest control or scheduled maintenance/repairs, or have called in a work order, it is extremely important that you inform the office before maintenance arrives at your unit.

Tortellini Soup

Ingredients:

- 1lb Italian sausage (browned & drained)
- 2 cans Italian diced tomatoes
- 4 cups vegetable or chicken broth
- 8 oz cream cheese (cubed)
- 4 cups fresh spinach
- 1 bag frozen cheese tortellini

Instructions:

- 1. Place everything except for the tortellini & spinach into slow cooker.
- 2. Cook on low for 4 hours.
- 3. Add tortellini and spinach and cook for additional 30 minutes.

Taco Soup

Ingredients:

- 1lb ground beef
- 1 onion diced
- 16oz pinto beans (drained & rinsed)
- 10oz Rotel
- 8oz tomato sauce
- 4oz green Chile peppers (diced)
- 2 cups beef broth
- ¾ cup frozen corn
- ¾ cup green pepper (diced, or ½ small green pepper)
- 1pkg taco seasoning mix (or homemade) Instructions
- 1. In a large pot, brown ground beef with onion until no pink remains.
- 2. Drain off any excess fat.
- 3. Add remaining ingredients to the pot. Bring to a boil. Turn down to simmer for 15-20 mins.

Notes: Leftovers can be stored in fridge for 3 days. Freeze for up to 2 months. Thaw and reheat on stove.
