- Pets **MUST** be on a leash when they are outside.
- Tenants are responsible for any and all damages done to a unit by their pet(s), service animal(s), or visiting animals. This includes damages to things such as the mini blinds, floors, walls, etc.
- Pick up after your pet. <u>Do not leave pet waste on the ground</u>. <u>Dispose of it properly.</u>

<u>Severe Weather</u> – As Spring approaches, it is time to prepare for severe weather. Preparation is key to staying safe. Some ways to prepare are:

- 1. Sign up for Alerts and Warnings.
- 2. Make a Plan.
- 3. Practice Emergency Drills.
- 4. Safeguard Documents.
- 5. Plan with Neighbors.
- 6. Know Evacuation Routes.
- 7. Assemble or Update Emergency Supplies.
