Attached to this newsletter are the documents
provided at the Public Hearing.

<u>Trashcan Pulls</u> – A service that will <u>no longer</u> be provided is "trash can pulling". This service is not something CHA will continue for several reasons, the two basics being labor costs and the consideration of the employee who has to leave their family time if Monday is a holiday. <u>Residents have until July 1, 2023</u>, to make arrangements for a family/friend/caretaker to assist with their trash can if they cannot take care of it themselves.

Furniture – When buying furniture, it is always a good idea to use caution, especially if you are buying secondhand furniture. Anytime you purchase secondhand furniture, if you call the office, maintenance will come check the furniture to make sure that it is free of bedbugs before you take it into your apartment. Like the old saying goes, "An ounce of prevention is worth a pound of cure."

<u>Annual Inspections</u> – Maintenance will be in <u>all</u> units between <u>March 6th – March 10th</u> for Annual Inspections. Notice will be given again in the next newsletter, but please be aware this is coming.

Go-Day/Interim Re-Exams — Attention: Residents on the sixty (60) day interim recertification schedule, please remember to keep your appointment and bring your completed paperwork. Re-Exams are February 15th and February 16th. It is YOUR responsibility to provide requested documentation. If you experience difficulties gathering your paperwork and/or keeping your appointment, you must contact the office before your appointment time. Households that do not comply with their lease agreement will be set at flat rate.

<u>Smoking</u> – Remember smoking in your unit, on your porches, or anywhere less than 25 feet away from the units is a smoking violation. A smoking violation can result in an eviction. This is not just limited to tenants, but also to any guest that a tenant has.

<u>Freezing Pipes</u> – When the temperature falls below 25°F, please remember the following:

- Open the doors to your kitchen sink and bathroom vanity.
- Turn the faucets in the kitchen sink, bathroom vanity, and shower/tub to a slow drip. (CHA pays for the water.)
- Leave the heat lamp in the storage room on if you have one. (Not all units are designed like that.)
- If you leave your unit overnight, please leave the heat on no lower than 60°F.
- Report any malfunctions occurring in your unit and do <u>not</u> allow family, friends, or outside "handymen" to attempt to "fix it for you". You will be responsible for any damages caused by their repair efforts. Call the office for a work order.
- Keep garden hoses unhooked and put away.
 Tenants are responsible for any damages caused by garden hoses that freeze while attached to the outside faucet.
- Space heaters are not allowed due to fire hazards.


